NIPSCO CANCELS PLANNED ELECTRIC OUTAGE FOR CROWN POINT

MERRILLVILLE, Ind. – Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSCO) today announced that a planned electric outage scheduled for tomorrow, August 16, to accommodate the relocation of a home located at 129th Ave. to a building site on 173rd Avenue in Crown Point has been postponed.

Customers who would have been impacted by the planned electric outage received a letter from NIPSCO dated July 27 advising them of the outage. An alternate date for the planned outage and relocation of the home has yet to be determined by the company responsible for moving the home. Once a date has been selected by the moving company, NIPSCO will notify those customers accordingly.

NIPSCO, with headquarters in Merrillville, Ind., is one of the 10 energy distribution companies of NiSource Inc. (NYSE: NI).
