## **ROAD WIDENING PROJECT TO RESULT IN PLANNED ELECTRIC OUTAGES IN AREAS OF MONTICELLO**

**MERRILLVILLE, Ind.** – Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSCO) today announced that there will be planned intermittent electric outages in a section of Monticello on Sat., Oct. 28 and Sun., Oct. 29, to accommodate the widening of Shafer Drive by White County Highway Department.

The areas affected by the intermittent outages are primarily east and west of Shafer Drive from County Road 225 N to and including Indiana Beach Drive. The outages could last up to three to four hours in some cases. NIPSCO customers are advised to contact 1-800-4-NIPSCO with questions.
